Class Expectations:

1. **Respect everyone in our learning community: Teachers, Support Staff, Peers**
2. **Raise your hand and wait to be called on**
3. **Do not speak while others are speaking**

 - a. **No colored pens allowed for assignments (only blue or black ink or pencil)**

Classroom Procedures:

1. **I expect that you will enter the room in an orderly fashion. Once you have arrived, please place backpacks in designated area, sit in your seat, take out your notebook, and do the opening activity that will be posted on the board. It may be Daily Oral Language, Vocabulary, or Journal entries.**
2. **You must be prepared for every class. It detracts from learning time if the class has to wait for you to locate the necessary utensils to begin your day. You received a list of necessary school supplies, and I expect you to use them.**

- 3. I also expect that you will be quiet while I am, or another classmate is speaking. You should not be out of your seat unless you have permission to do so.**
- 4. All electronic devices are prohibited in the classroom (cell phones, Ipods, mp3's, game systems). Please store these devices in your locker between the hours of 7:55am-2:55pm. Items seen or heard during this period will be taken and turned in to the principal for parent/guardian retrieval.**

Consequence System:

Step 1: Restate class expectation, warning given

Step 2: Incident recorded, and/or consequence given

Step 3: Incident recorded, and/or parent contacted

Step 4: Administrative Referral
